The Fruit of the Spirit = Evidences that we are truly stalking Jesus.

Joy [Jesus' joy was shown in how He loved His Disciples]

John 2:2, 11-12; John 4:2; John 15:10-12; John 16:19-24; Psalm 51:8;

Rom. 15:13; James 1:2-4

Joy is a blessing for the believer. Joy removes any barrier from enjoying all that God has given you.

What does Joy say in my life?

Peace [He lived with and knew the betrayer was amongst them and it did not deter His walk, His call, His decisions, His actions.]

John 12:4-6; Mark 14:17-21; Philippians 4:7; Ephesians 6:11-13

What does Peace say in my life?

Kindness [Shown in the attitude Jesus had towards children. And in His disbursement of the Holy Spirit on us.]

What does Kindness say in my life?

Goodness {Generosity: Our living testimony} [Jesus giving...The Seventy-Two]

What does Goodness say in my life?

Faithfulness {loyalty and trustworthiness}[Jesus completed the calling of His life. In 33 years.]

What does Faithfulness say in my life?

Gentleness [Jesus' treatment of the women with the issue of blood]

What does Gentleness say in my life?

Patience {Optimistic waiting} [Lived by Jesus as he loved Lazarus, Mary, Martha]

John 11; Psalm 86:15; 1 Corinthians 13:4, 7; Colossians 1:9-12; Joel 2:13; Ephesians 4:1-3

What does Patience say in my life?

Self Control {practicing His presence} [Gethsemane...a living example]

Matthew 26:36-46; Psalm 19:14; 1 Tim. 4:7, 8; Titus 2:4, 5; Heb. 12:11; 2 Pet. 1:5--7

What does Self Control say in my life?

Love {not just action, but inner conviction, attitude} [The Cross...the greatest act of love.]

Philippians 2:5-11; 1 Corinthians 13:4-8; 1 John 3:17

What does Love say in my life?
